The CheXpress CX30 provides a number of new features including two patent-pending technologies for adaptive Magnetic Ink Character Recognition (MICR) and scan and return mode of operation. The CheXpress CX30 is also the first scanner in its class to support 300 and 240 dpi scanning in black and white, grayscale and color.

The CX30 scanner offers a smaller footprint in comparison to other check scanners. The energy efficient check scanner requires less energy by incorporating lower-power consuming components and provides automatic shutdown capabilities. The device also operates more quietly than typical check scanners.
